CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entrants must produce a current BJC licence on the day.
2. Entrants licence must include a photograph and date of birth.
3. Closing date for all entries will be last post Wednesday 11th March 2009.
4. Late entries are subject to a £2 surcharge.
5. Only team managers will be allowed to consult with the Mat Marshal.
6. Competitors may only enter 1 category.
7. The BJC reserve the right to photograph or film all or any part of the tournament.

COMPETITION REGULATIONS

1. No coaching will be allowed during the competition.
2. Judogi must comply with current BJC contest rules (**January 2008**)
3. Females must wear a plain white t-shirt.
4. The trousers shall reach more than Halfway down the calf to a minimum of 5cm above the ankle bone, but not so far to cover the ankle bone.
5. No refreshments to be taken to the side of the mat. Drinking water will be available from the "table".
6. All competitors must comply with the regulations regarding footwear, i.e. Zori's only to be worn to the side of the mat. Trainers and everyday shoes are not permitted.
7. Where there are sufficient numbers, categories will be fought in preliminary round pools, then knockout.
8. Where permitting, Gold, Silver and 2 Bronze awards will be made in all categories.
