**New BJC qualifications available at St Ives Easter course  
alongside use of the new Grading syllabus**

The St Ives Easter course will be host to the first of the following New BJC qualifications:

**Club Grading Administrator and Area Grading administrator : –**

These qualifications are open to licence holders and non licence holders. These courses will run simultaneously. The courses are targeted at those who assist with the administration of the gradings at Club and at Area level, to promote a consistent method of running a grading throughout the BJC.

**Club Grading Officer and Area Grading Officer: -**

These qualifications are technical and only available to BJC Licence holders only. To take the club or area grading officer qualification you need to be a BJC registered coach. If you are interested in taking the area grading officer please contact Head Office. These courses will also run simultaneously. Please note that to be qualified as a grading officer you must also have the relevant administrators award.

**FPJ Level 1 & 2 Revalidation/ Short course.**

This course will be available at St Ives and will only be available to those who are revalidating. It is a short course of approx three hours. Candidates should already hold both FPJ level 1 & 2 qualifications.

All of these courses will be included in the St Ives course fee, alternatively if you wish to take them without attending the full course the cost is £15 per person per course.

**In addition there will be a short introduction and question and answer session to the new Grading syllabus. This will be free of charge.**
