Technical Notice

FPJ Revalidation Period - 3 years

With immediate effect:

If you hold FPJ level 1 BJC <u>only</u> coaching qualification the revalidation will be required by attending a FPJ level 1 or Level 2 course within 3 years of the previous validity date.

If you hold both FPJ level 1 and 2 BJC coaching qualifications revalidation will be by attending either a FPJ level 1 or a FPJ level 2 course within 3 years of the previous validity date.

However the attendance to these courses must alternate between level 1 and level 2 to maintain a working knowledge of any updates that may occur with these courses.

Points of Clarification:

It is intended that candidates will revalidate during the 3rd year, before the expiry date of their most recent FPJ.

Therefore in these cases the new of expiry date will be set 3 years from the expiry date of the previous award of that level.

If validity has already expired the new date expiry will be 3 years from the date of the revalidation course.

The effect of current CPD Pilot scheme will be addressed at a later date.
