## New Structure for BJC-Technical Centre Referees Group

Due to Tony Grigg's unfortunate withdrawal as Refereeing Group Leader we will now operate a new concept for the Referee and Table Official Groups.

In both areas we have a number of experienced officers who have devotedly looked after our needs for many years and now do not really want to take on long term commitments but are willing to help us establish a good future set-up.

The Chair persons will not be authorised to make decisions on behalf of whole Forum Group. The Table Official Group will continue to submit matters through the Referees Forum. We shall be looking for new long-term persons to become Chairs of both forums.

The President would like those who have not responded to be kept informed by being on the Forum circulation list and their input at any time will be welcome. However it will be assumed that if they make no response they have no comments to make on the subjects circulated.

#### **Duties** of the two Forums will include:

- 1. Given the authority to co-ordinate nationally the refereeing structure.
- 2. To continue with the **established** procedure/trail of assessment.
- 3. To contact all Area Technical Officers and send to them the 'Procedure/Trail' of assessment.
- 4. To set out a programme of Training availability. (Dates, venues etc).
- 5. To ensure that results of assessment are notified to Head Office, GR Mealing Registrar and Paul Laskey Chief Examiner.
- 6. Be provided with the latest assessment papers for all the relevant Referee qualifications.
- 7. Be given a list of active Referees and their Qualifications.
- 8. Be funded for at least two Seminars per annum held at say Squad Training. Minimum to be mileage money (subject to Tech Budget and HQC approval).
- 9. Be aware that that the aim is not to take on all IJF amendments but to keep to the spirit/tenor of BJC Principles.
